### Beginner Knitting!

Your final week will be set aside for learning how to weave in ends and blocking. You can choose a gradient yarn or pair colorful tonals for a plainer version. Add a contrasting border and voila...super stylish!

## Building Blocks Blanket!

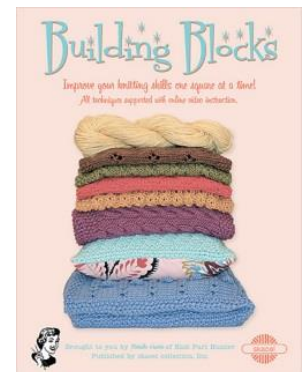

After all the blocks are completed, we will block, seam, and finish the blanket with a gorgeous edge. Knit with Plymouth Worsted Merino Superwash, Encore, Mirasol Sisa or Ella Rae Cashmereno Aran. This is an 8-month commitment!

**Yarn:** Worsted, Aran or Chunky Weight Yarn

In this class fiber artist Kerstin Katko (aka Ducky from Ducky's Sheep Shack) will teach you how to sculpt sheep wool into a Santa Claus decoration. You'll have choice of skin color and shape. You can make a tall Father Christmas or a rounder Santa! While felting has been around for centuries, needle felting is a relatively new craft. It involves using barbed felting needles to compact and shape wool into sculpture. Once you try it, you'll be hooked! We will be using sharp needles so a few poked fingers are possible, but lots of creative fun is inevitable!
