Tunisian (also known as Afghan) Crochet makes a dense fabric with a beautiful texture. You will be using a different type of hook than your regular crochet hook. Tunisian crochet is a fun and necessary addition to your crochet tool kit AND you don't have to be an experienced crocheter to learn Tunisian crochet. It is a very relaxing and rewarding type of crochet. Learn the basic techniques and make a washcloth in this class. Then on to blankets, table runners... you name it!

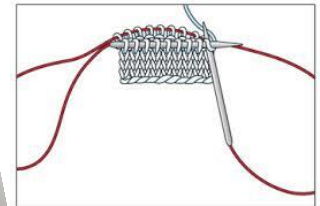
