## Cozy Classic Raglan Sweater!

This top-down sweater is the perfect go-to pattern to have in your tool box. It's classic style lends itself to any yarn or combinations of yarn for a DK weight. You can make it dressy for a night out or comfy for everyday wear. You will learn the tubular cast on and bind off, short rows for neck shaping, and lifted increases for shaping the raglan. The pattern does show a cropped version so if you want to make it longer be sure to check the pattern, it will tell you how many extra yards you need per inch.

## Felted Santa!

In this class fiber artist Kerstin Katko (aka Ducky from Ducky's Sheep Shack) will teach you how to sculpt sheep wool into a Santa Claus decoration. You'll have choice of skin color and shape. You can make a tall Father Christmas or a rounder Santa! While felting has been around for centuries, needle felting is a relatively new craft. It involves using barbed felting needles to compact and shape wool into sculpture. Once you try it, you'll be hooked! We will be using sharp needles so a few poked fingers are possible, but lots of creative fun is inevitable!
