Beginner Knitting!

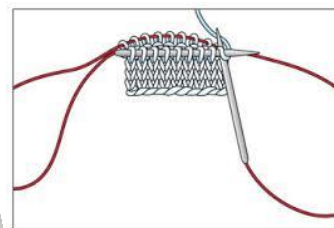

Flashpoint Hat!

Let's keep the Brioche going...this hat is a great next project if you are looking to take your traveling brioche up a level. Knit two-color brioche in the round and work decreases for the crown using dpns or magic loop (experience with either required). These two skills alone will kick your brioche up a notch! Practicing your directional decreases with a few back-to-back projects helps to secure your brioche confidence.

Scarf Necklace with Beads!

It would even make a great gift for all the dragon lovers out there!

From Swatch to Aurealis!

If you've always wanted to knit a stranded sweater but we're not sure where to start, this class is for you. We will begin with a three-hour stranding workshop to set you up for success, followed by three regular classes to knit your sweater. The Aurealis is a stunning short sleeve stranded pattern and perfect for a first colorwork sweater. Pair a solid main color with a beautiful variegated yarn to make the stranding pop. This is an advanced class, you must have knit a top-down sweater previously and be familiar with knitting in the round, German short rows and picking up sleeve stitches.

Socks can be knit all year round! Stay cool in these fun shortie socks. Learn the tips and tricks to knitting a well-fitting sock with fingering weight yarn. These top-down socks feature a heel flap and gusset. Choose your favorite color and you'll be wearing them in no time.

Yarn: Sweet Georgia, Andromeda Sock, Opal or any sock weight yarn

They are so much fun to make... you will want to make more and more.

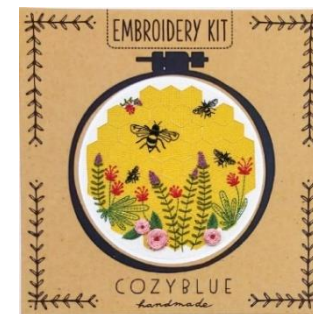

Shibori/Indigo Dyeing!

Introducing Sue Fox Mitrano from Blue Fox Studio and her AMAZING Shibori art...In this beginner friendly workshop, you'll learn the art of Shibori, a Japanese manual hand-dyeing technique which produces beautiful patterns in fabric in a range of blues using Indigo dye. Four different patterns will be taught. Choose from: One 8"x72" silk scarf and One 11"x60" scarf **OR** Two 18"x18" cotton zippered pillow covers **OR** One large cotton tote bag w/pocket 19"x17"x9.5" You'll choose two techniques to prep your fabrics. Dress for mess, as the dye will stain clothing. All supplies included.

Project: Make two scarfs, two pillow cases or one cotton tote!

Quality Merino wool and all supplies are included in the fee. Participants are also welcome to bring additional bits of 100% natural yarn/fiber to include in their artwork. **(Bring a bagged lunch)**
