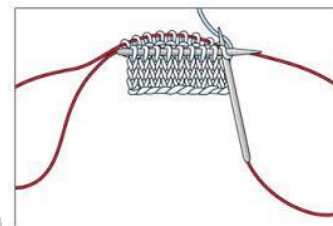

Top with a pom pom and you're ready to go! Check out our model that we have "glammed it up" with Art yarns.

## Chunky Hat Workshop!

In this workshop you'll master the Leaf Stitch, a slip stitch technique that allows you to add a pop of color to stockinette knitting. This hat is knit up in 2 colors of everyone's favorite, Malabrigo Rasta! The pattern works up quickly and makes for an impressive holiday gift. Be prepared to come to class with your brim completed so we can jump right in.

This little stylish piece packs a knitting punch! Started flat from the bottom, simple textures combine with decreases and yarn overs to make an engaging project. Once the bottom is complete join in the round and knit to your desired height. Worked up in a super soft yarn, the biggest challenge will be picking a color.

## Strong Hearts Scarf!

Let's keep the Brioche trend going! If you have taken the brioche basics and are craving more, this class is for you. Scarves make such a statement throughout the winter. Worn with or without a coat on, stay stylish and keep warm all this season. Recap two-color brioche worked flat, cabling in brioche and how to work the selvedge edges in order to create a tidy shape from start to finish. Contrast is king...time to pick a color!

## Bide Shawl!

Wrap a loved one in warmth and style this holiday season. This top-down triangle shawl knits up quickly in a chunky yarn. Stockinette, garter and lace stitches all combine to keep things interesting but not too challenging. With two sizes to choose from, learn to master K2tog, SSK and lastly yarn overs. The goal will be to block your completed shawls together in the last class to complete this all around great project.

**Project:** Bide Shawl by Helen Stewart

**Yarn:** Malabrigo Mecha or Plymouth Superwash Select Chunky

## Warm Me Tee!

There are some great techniques to learn on this top-down sleeveless sweater. It has a rolled hem at the neck, a cute knit bobble to add texture (learn two styles and choose your favorite!), a built in slipped stitch edge at the sleeve and is finished off with a 1 x 1 rib. Wear it over a tank, tee or turtleneck to make this a very versatile piece of clothing that can be worn all year long! (Must know how to work in the round)

This class will feature working with dpns, learning to cable, knitting in the round and changing over to working flat. This project can be done with magic loop method. (Magic loop experience required)

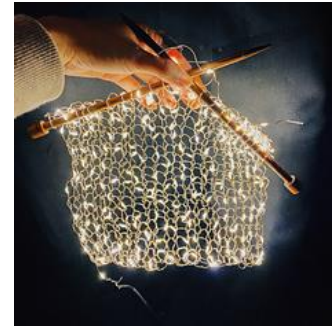
**Pattern:** Free patterns handed out at class per fiber sport!

## Learn to Weave on a Rigid Heddle Loom!

Rigid Heddle weaving is an enjoyable and easy way to learn to weave beautiful projects. Your new 16" Ashford rigid heddle loom will be able to weave a variety of items.

In the first class, participants will learn the art of weaving on a rigid heddle loom. Attendees will learn the parts of the loom, weaving terminology, project planning, and to warp (dressing the loom with its vertical threads) and weave (placing the horizontal threads) to make a beautiful scarf.

The weaving of your scarf will be finished at home using your new skills. The second class will include removing the scarf from the loom and finishing the ends. The different ways weavers can finish their ends will also be discussed. Time will be given for weavers to re-warp their loom with a new project to reinforce the skills learned.

You'll have a choice of skin color and a variety of colors to choose from when creating the hat. Curly locks will finish of your gnome and assure their sense of style.

While felting has been around for centuries, needle felting is a relatively new craft. It involves using barbed felting needles to compact and shape natural fibers into sculpture. Once you try it you'll be hooked! We will be using sharp needles so a few poked fingers are possible, but lots of creative fun is inevitable! Supplies included.
