## First Hat!

Stop knitting back and forth and start knitting in the round! Hats are a great project because they are quick and there is always someone in your life who needs one. Knit in-the-round from the bottom up, learn all the basics of hat knitting including joining in the round, sizing, crown decreasing, and using double point needles (DPNs) to finish the top.

From start to finish you will be engaged and excited to watch your pattern evolve.

Master working with double point needles as you knit these mitts up in a beautiful soft yarn like Classic Alpaca DK.

## First Sweater, Nights!!

The Ankers Sweater is a popular one! This beautiful sweater is perfect for a first sweater and you can choose from short or long sleeves. It is a comfortable and reliable “go to” favorite for any wardrobe. For a first sweater you will be also be surprised at how easy it is to tailor to your size. Learn how to work a top-down yoke construction that is knit in-the-round with no seaming!!! Simple sections of rib and increases create a beautiful texture to your fabric. This class is a great introduction for knitting garments in the round and magic loop for your sleeves.

## Rib Wave!

It's almost Spring! Time to freshen up your wardrobe with this beautifully textured knit Sweater featuring ribbing and cables. It is knit top-down with a unique construction. Starting at the shoulder you will knit the front of the sweater down to the armhole. Then picking up stitches at the shoulder, you will work the back down to the armhole. After joining in the round, you will complete the body. Techniques are ribbing stitches, cables, German short rows and reading charts. This sweater has gorgeous sleeve detail...you too can knit one for yourself and show them off!!

## Toe Up Sock!

It's time to knit socks from the toe up! Why? There's lots of pros to knitting socks from the toe up including the ease of trying them on; allowing you to customize the fit as you knit, a heel that doesn't require you to pick up stitches and the ability to knit your sock leg until you run out of yarn. Knit on magic loop and starting with the Turkish cast on, these fingering weight “So Vanilla Socks” knit up beautifully, especially in self-striping and patterning yarns. Featuring a traditional short row heel, this is the perfect place to master wrap and turn short rows.

**Yarn:** Universal Easel, Sweet Georgia, or Opal sock yarn

## How to Make a Granny Square!

Learn to create shape using increases and decreases to form all body parts, how to stuff and join parts and embellish your cute bunny to customize for its new owner. Your bunnies will be complete just in time for Easter!

## Introduction to Needle Felted Painting!

Needle felting is one of the many forms of felting that exists in the fiber world. Works of art can be created large and small. Exploring different tools, you will learn how to start with a fiber foundation and to make a background from scratch, how to mix blend and mix fibers, create dimension and work both small and large details. At the end of class, you will learn a surprise element to add another level of texture to your piece.

## Learn to Weave on a Rigid Heddle Loom!

Rigid Heddle weaving is an enjoyable and easy way to learn to weave beautiful projects. Your new 16" Ashford rigid heddle loom will be able to weave a variety of items.

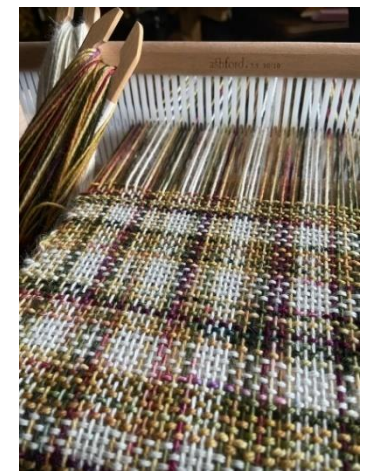
In the first class, participants will learn the art of weaving on a rigid heddle loom. Attendees will learn the parts of the loom, weaving terminology, project planning, and to warp (dressing the loom with its vertical threads) and weave (placing the horizontal threads) to make a scarf.

The weaving of your beautiful scarf will be finished at home using your new skills. The second class will include removing the scarf from the loom and finishing the ends. The different ways weavers can finish their ends will also be discussed. Time will be given for weavers to re-warp their loom with a new project to reinforce the skills learned.

## Advanced Color Techniques in Weaving!

Learn to weave with style on your rigid heddle loom with this log cabin pattern! Color and weave is a way that creates the illusion of complex, interesting and just a bit fancy patterns within plain weave. A rigid heddle loom is perfect for this fabulous pattern, which can be made using solid or self-stripping yarn.

In this next step weaving class, participants **must** have a rigid heddle loom with a 7.5 dent reed and understand the basics of warping and weaving on their loom. Looms can be any width or brand. This class will teach the log cabin pattern, how to read a weaving pattern and hem stitching the ends (as opposed to tying knots). Participants can choose between weaving a scarf or table runner.

## Learn to Spin Yarn on an Electric Wheel!... (NO wheel needed)

Hand spinning yarn from fiber is easy to achieve with a little practice and some basic rules. Learning to spin yarn on an electric wheel lets you concentrate on the “hands” in hand spinning.

An electric spinning wheel is a device that spins yarn or thread from fiber of your choice, Electric spinning wheels or e-Spinners offer speed, efficiency, and portability. AND...you do not need to know anything about yarn, knitting or crocheting to learn. This is a true beginner friendly class and a new fiber sport, as we like to say.

Come have fun while creating yarn from local fibers and explore prep, drafting, twist and plying to create a one-of-a-kind skein. Electric wheels will be available to use in class and supplies included.
